Home Nations Qualifier	8 <sup>th</sup> May 2016 – Nottingham PC, Mercia	5-round Swiss System format for competition to find Top 8 teams to qualify for England representation in Edinburgh 2016.
Men's Triples Championship	<ul> <li>Round 1, 15<sup>th</sup> May 2016 – Hartley PC, Kent</li> <li>Round 2, 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2016 – Oxshott PC, Southern</li> <li>Top 8, 24<sup>th</sup> July 2016 – Arlesey PC - Chiltern</li> </ul>	Format will depend on numbers, but unlikely to use Swiss System. Teams required to play as a 4 in at least one out of the two qualifying rounds and the Top 8. Aim to offer teams minimum of 5 games, all entry fees net of expenses will be offered as cash prizes. Teams can enter and play one or both qualifying rounds with no requirement to play Top 8.

Aim to offer players minimum of 5 games, all entry fees net of expenses will be offered as cash prizes. Players can enter as many of the rankings tournaments as they like as they are standalone competitions. Results of Round 1 tournament combined with the results of the Women's Singles at National Titles weekend to identify England representative at the European Singles Championship in Nimes, France (November 2016, date to be confirmed by the CEP). Results of Round 2 tournament combined with the results of the Women's Doubles at National Titles weekend to identify England representatives at the World Singles, Doubles and Mixed Doubles Championship in Ghent, Belgium (April 13th – 16th, 2017). Teams not required to play as a 4 in Round 3.

Combined with result of Round 1 of the Women's National Rankings  Tournament the result of this competition will be used to identify the Winner the representative of England at the European Singles Championship in Nimes, France (November 2016, date to be confirmed by the CEP) and the World Singles, Doubles and Mixed Doubles Championship in Ghent, Belgium (April 13 <sup>th</sup> – 16 <sup>th</sup> , 2017).
