We are busy preparing the paperwork for competition entry, fleshing out the outline plans for the various Commissions and Groups to ensure they can deliver to their aims and ensuring all the other structures we need are in place.

You will shortly see one of the first administrative changes when you receive the paperwork for the first General Meeting, happening on 21st April. From now on it will be a lot easier for all members to be involved with the decision making process as we are introducing proxy voting. Full details will be sent with the notices at the relevant time, so keep your eyes open for that.

INTER-REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

After many comments last year about the availability of space at Mill Rythe we have introduced a slightly different system this year for bookings.

The main problem is that there just aren't enough beds there for everyone who wants to stay. The usable capacity for us is about 600 beds and our maximum number of players is much higher than that. Therefore, for an initial period, we have allocated each Region approximately 2/3 of their maximum squad size.

Any spare rooms available at the end of this time period will be redistributed across the waiting list.

Unfortunately we can't make Mill Rythe's owners build more accommodation, but we have tried to ensure equal access.

This year's Titles Weekend is taking place in Gravesend, Kent, a part of the country that may not be as well known as some of our previous venues, such as Exeter and the Isle of Wight so I thought it might be an idea to tell you a bit about the area, particularly if you are thinking of bringing non players with you.

Gravesend itself does not necessarily have a great deal to offer the tourist (I can say that, I was born there) Pocahontas is buried in the town and the Napoleonic Fort and surrounding gardens are interesting, but it is a great location for exploring from with fantastic road and rail links to London and the rest of Kent.

Thanks to the HS1 London St Pancras is only 25 minutes away and there are good train links to Canterbury for some history or Whitstable, Margate and Ramsgate for those needing a bit of sea air and a paddle.

Bluewater is a short bus, train or drive away and Westfield Stratford is easily accessed by train in just 17 minutes.

There are numerous English Heritage and National Trust sites in the area too. Leeds Castle, just 30 minutes away by car and only a short train journey, is hosting a Grand Medieval Joust that weekend which should be a sight to see.

Hopefully everyone can find something there to interest them, so bring the family along—we would be delighted to see them all.
